

New payment arrangements

- · You can no longer pay the Dartford Crossing charge at the barriers.
- Instead, you need to pay in advance of your journey or by midnight the following day.
- You can save up to one-third on every crossing by setting up a pre-pay account.
- · Alternatively, you can make one-off payments online, by phone, at Payzone retail outlets or in advance by post.

- Drivers who don't pay the charge will face a penalty.
- It is still free to use the Crossing between 10pm and 6am.

Road improvements

- Major improvement works are underway and will continue until spring 2015.
- The works will replace the current 27 lanes and payment booths with a much simpler road layout with four lanes in each direction.
- New traffic management measures are also being installed on the northbound approach to the tunnels to maintain safety and manage over-sized vehicles and those carrying dangerous goods.
