Your Arrival on Site

The nearest train station is 4 miles from site. The nearest bus stop is approx. 1 mile for site.

There are two brown signs off the A35, one large site sign on entrance.

There is one site barrier that is automatic on exit. It's locked between 11pm and 7am.

Overnight parking is available 200 metres away outside of the site.



The visitors parking doubles as the overnight car park, but visitors are able to park next to their friend's unit on site.

The main reception car park can hold at least eight cars.

The overnight car park can hold at least six cars.

New arrivals should pull up to reception. The surface is tarmac and its reasonably level.

There are now designated accessible spaces but plenty of spaces a short, level distance from the reception.

There is a handrail attached to the reception wall.

There are no steps but a gentle incline.

There are potted plants along the path.



Your Check In

The reception is clearly signed for arrivals.

It is open from 8.30am until 5pm or 7pm, depending on season.

There are level concrete slabs.

There is a slight lip on the door.

There is good clear floor space in reception.

There is no low-level reception counter.



Your Pitch

Cars can be parked next to most pitches on site.

Four pitches are close to the accessible room.

All hardstanding pitches are gravel and some have pea gravel suitable for tents with groundsheets.

Many level hardstanding and grass pitches are close to the site road.





Travelling Around Site

There are speedbumps along the main site road.

At night there is low level lighting on the outside of all blocks and the rest of the site is dimly lit by hook-up bollards.

There are a small number of benches dotted around the site.



The Facility Block

There is a clear, well-maintained path leading to the facilities.

There is a gentle ramp leading into the blocks.

There are steps into the ladies and gents, level to family and accessible room.

There are no semi-ambulant cubicles in either the men's or ladies.

All sinks have lever taps throughout.

There are fold down seats in all showers.

The showers are operated by a push button in men's and ladies and a dial in the family room.

The are no steps into the showers.

The facility block has low level, wall mounted lights.



The Accessible Facilities

There is a flat level concrete slab path leading to the accessible facility.

There are handrails leading to the accessible facility. As you approach the right rail is wall mounted and the left is free standing.

There is flat level access into the accessible facility.

There are handrails next to the toilet.

There is a regular size flush handle.

There is transfer space to the left of the toilet.



The wash basin cannot be reached from the toilet.

The washbasin has larger than normal lever top taps.

There is a hand dryer located in the room.

There is a low-level mirror above the sink that does not extend to full height.

The shower has a number of handrails.

The shower is dial operated.

The shower is open access, not a cubicle.

The shower head is height adjustable.

The floor is nonslip.

There is a hair dryer.

There is an emergency cord next to the toilet and in the shower. Both can be reached from the floor.

The emergency alarm can be heard from both staff pitches and also reception.

The accessible room can be accessed with a RADAR key.



Laundry & Food Preparation Areas

The laundry and food preparation areas both have level access.

The approach path is concrete.

The taps are screw top.

There are four washing machines which are front loading and can be reached from the floor.

There are four tumble dryers which are top loading and can be reached from the floor.

There is a wall mounted iron.

There is a freestanding iron.

There are indoor washing up facilities.



All washing up sinks have screw top taps.

There is an outdoor drying area with one rota dryers.

There is no low-level sink in both the washing up area.



Recreational Areas

There is an indoor recreation area.

There is a slight ramp leading to this area.

There are no steps leading to the indoor recreational area.

There is a variety of seating available such as sofas and freestanding chairs.

There is an outdoor children play area.

This is accessible over grass with no designated path.

There are several seating areas overlooking the play area.

The play area has a bark surface with raise edges surrounding it to keep the bark in place.



Waste, Water, Fire and Evacuation

There is a slight slope leading up to the refuse areas.

There are no steps or kerbs restricting access to the refuse areas.

There is a waist high fence either side or the entrance ramp which may be used as a handrail and a fence surrounding the compound.

All bins on site are full height industrial 1100L units.

There is a fire triangle located at all water points which has unrestricted accessed over grass.

All fire extinguishers can be accessed over grass or on tarmac depending on the position.

Campers are briefed about the fire assembly point on arrival. There are clear signs.
